This year marks the 200th anniversary of winemaking in Ontario. To commemorate this milestone the Niagara chapter is planning events which will look at the evolution of wine and winemaking in Ontario.

Join us at Lailey Vineyard in Niagara-on-the-Lake for the first tasting in this series as we explore “**Grapes and the Vineyard**”. The vineyards at Lailey were first planted in 1970 by Donna and David Lailey. Donna was a Grape Queen in 1991 and will speak to us about some of the techniques she has used in her career as a viticulturist. In addition, we will hear about the life of a vineyard worker and the perspective of the Grape Growers Association of Ontario. We will break into groups and move through three tasting stations in different areas of the winery, each with one or more speakers, wines to taste, and food to eat.

The food will be prepared by Chef Mark Hand of “Hospitality on Hand” catering company.

At the start of the evening we will review the past year and have our annual elections and present awards. Come out and enjoy another great OWS Niagara event!!

Directions: From the QEW, take the Niagara-on-the-Lake exit (#38B), the Niagara-on-the-Lake signs will lead you to Highway #55. Drive 12 km along Highway #55 toward Niagara-on-the-Lake and turn right on East and West Line, at the third set of traffic lights in Virgil. Drive until you reach the end of East and West Line (about 4 km). Turn right on the Niagara Parkway and drive less than half a kilometre and you will find the winery at the bend in the road, on the right with a sign reading Lailey Vineyard and Winery.
