Join us for our first Toronto event of the Ontario Wine Society's 20th Anniversary year - 2011 - a rare opportunity to taste the single grain whiskies that make Forty Creek unique.



First generation whisky maker, John Hall uses his wine making background to

highlight the best characteristics of rye, Indian corn and malted barley by distilling and ageing separately before blending the 3 to create Forty Creek Barrel Select. Taste the individual whiskies and discover the unique taste characteristics that each contribute to the final blend.

We are also featuring 2 limited edition Forty Creek releases – Forty Creek Double Barrel, aged in first run bourbon barrels, and Forty Creek Confederation Oak – the first Canadian Whisky ever aged in Canadian Oak barrels. Forty Creek Barrel Select is the fastest growing whisky in Canada, and the first successful new Canadian whisky launched in over 70 years!

A special blend of tradition and innovation sets Kittling Ridge apart as both a winery and distillery. Owner, winemaker and whisky maker John Hall, purchased the facility in 1992. Since then Kittling Ridge has won wide recognition for its innovative approach to wine making and distilling. A proud recipient of thousands of international awards, including being named 2008 Canadian Distillery of the year by Whisky Magazine, the company offers a diverse portfolio, including Forty Creek Barrel Select Whisky, Prince Igor Vodka and Icewine and Brandy.



One of either Beth Warner, Vice President Marketing & Retail, or her husband Dave, Territory Manager, Niagara Region, both Kittling Ridge in-house whisky experts and sommeliers, will lead the tasting.

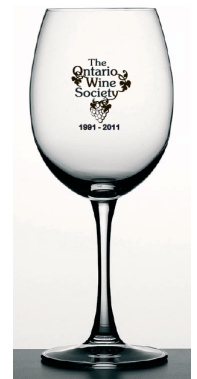

A plate of appetizers will be served.

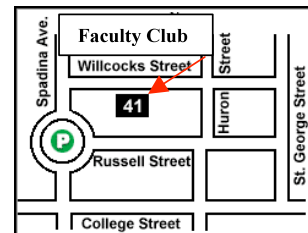
