“Red Paw – Black Paw” Terroir Tasting
at Coyote’s Run Estate Winery

What an opportunity Coyote’s Run Estate Winery has created for the Oenophile: a wonderful chance to compare **terroir** with their *Red Paw* and *Black Paw* wines. Coyote’s Run is situated on a unique vineyard that has two very distinct soil types - one soil is lighter and reddish in colour, the other is darker and more blackish in colour. Since they have the same varietals planted on both soil types, the winemaker wanted to see if the soil impacted the taste of the wine. The grapes from each of the vineyards were harvested separately then vinified, and aged exactly the same to see the difference only the soil made in the taste of the wines.



At this event, we’ll taste four different wines in both Red Paw and Black Paw terroirs (for a total of 8 wines) side by side, to evaluate for ourselves the differences. We’ll be tasting the 2006 and 2007 Cabernet Francs, and the 2006 and 2007 Pinot Noirs. To facilitate our tastings, our guest speakers for the evening will be **Jeff Aubry** – President, **Dave Sheppard** – Winemaker, and **Steven Trussler** – Assistant Winemaker. Each of the wine pairs will be featured at a different location within the winery so we’ll get to tour the facility and vineyard at the same time as enjoying the wines (seating will be available at each station). It will be a fun, interactive night with plenty of opportunity to have your questions answered.

Afterwards, we will mingle in the boutique and eat tasty nibblies, prepared by our caterer David House. **Please remember to wear jackets and comfortable shoes** as this event will include a walk out to the vineyard to see the soil first hand (weather permitting).

Directions: Coyote’s Run Winery - Take *exit 38B* (Niagara Stone Rd Hwy55) and *turn right* onto Glendale Ave. At the lights, *turn right* onto York Rd. Travel approx. 3km and *turn left* (North) onto Concession 6 Rd. At the stop sign *turn right* (East) onto Queenston Rd. Travel approx. 1km and *turn left* (North) onto Concession 5 Rd.
