Featuring award winning wines from Rosehall Run, Black Prince and Alvento

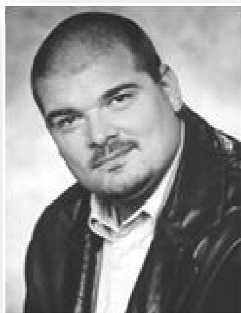

Fortessa of Canada wanted to do something very special for OWS members to start 2010 with a truly memorable event. We have arranged to have one of our favourite presenters do a tasting with five of Schott Zwiesel's break-resistant elegant, crystal wine glasses to match wonderful VQA wines ... **and you get to keep the stemware!**

Join us at **Cannery Restaurant**, nestled at the heart of the Distillery District, as Michael Pinkus, "The Grape Guy", and our generous host, Lloyd Thistle, President of Fortessa of Canada, guide us through a truly unique tasting experience. We will explore the theory that each varietal can better express its distinctive characteristics when tasted in the appropriately shaped stemware.



Schott Zwiesel stemware is made from Tritan crystal, which has an exceptionally brilliant yet hard surface that is resistant to scratching and dishwasher corrosion. Lloyd Thistle will provide information about the stemware, which the company claims has a breakage rate up to 40% lower than traditional crystal glasses. When the tasting is over, each attendee will receive the set of the five different glasses used for the tasting. The suggested retail value of the five crystal wine glasses is \$65.



Michael Pinkus is the head writer for the Ontario Wine Review. He was in top form as the entertaining guest speaker at our Days of Wine and Chocolate tasting event in January 2009. His passion for wines and his enthusiastic approach made the event completely enjoyable. Most recently, Michael placed a very respectable, and very Canadian, 4th in the 2009 Tasting Challenge against 250 amateur and professional winos. Whatever he does, it is Michael's desire to educate, inspire and encourage others to grow their own love and enthusiasm for wine – and to realize that it is their palate that ultimately makes the decision.
